
A Biblical Approach to Disciple-
Making

I. Come and See

- 📖 Passages: John 1:35–4:46
- Time Frame: ~4 months
- ◆ Jesus invites individuals to observe His ministry.
- ◆ Key moments:
 - - John the Baptist identifies Jesus (John 1:35–36)
 - - The calling of early disciples
 - - The wedding at Cana (first miracle)
 - - Teaching moments with Nicodemus & Samaritan woman.



II. Come and Follow Me

- 
- 📖 Passages: Matthew 4:19; Mark 1:16–18
 - Time Frame: ~10 months
 - ◆ Jesus calls for a deeper commitment.
 - ◆ Disciples leave their professions to follow Him full-time.
 - ◆ Key aspects:
 - - Hands-on training & ministry experience.
 - - Observing Jesus' teaching, healing, and interactions.

III. Come Be With Me

- 📖 Passages: Mark 3:13–14;
Luke 6:12–16
- Time Frame: ~1 year
- ◆ Jesus selects twelve apostles for intensive training.
- ◆ Key aspects:
 - - Learning through parables and private explanations.
 - - Witnessing miracles and leadership development.
 - - Preparing for future ministry roles.

IV. Remain in
Me, So I Send
You
(Post-
Resurrection
Phase)

- 📖 Passage: John 15:7-12, 20:19-31
- Duration: Ongoing
- ♦ Empowerment by the Holy Spirit to continue Christ's mission.
- ♦ The Great Commission: Making disciples of all nations (Matt 28:18-20).

Six-Step Coaching Process

(Bill Hull: Disciple-making
Pastor)

1 Tell Them What - Explain the task.

2 Tell Them Why - Provide the rationale.

3 Show Them How - Demonstrate through example.

4 Do It with Them - Guide & support.

5 Let Them Do It - Encourage independence.

6 Deploy Them - Send them to disciple others.

Roadmap for Disciple- Making



Following Jesus' model:

1 New Believers: Learn basics & engage in church.

2 Growing Disciples: Develop personal devotion & service.

3 Maturing Disciples: Lead small groups & share faith.

4 Disciple-Makers: Mentor others & lead ministries.

● Growing Disciples:

- Consistent devotional life.
 - Participate in small groups.
 - Serve in the church.

Maturing Disciples & Disciple- Makers

● Maturing Disciples:

- Deepen biblical knowledge.
 - Take on leadership roles.
 - Mentor new believers.

● Disciple-Makers:

- Lead ministries & small groups.
 - Teach & mentor others.
 - Actively make new disciples.
